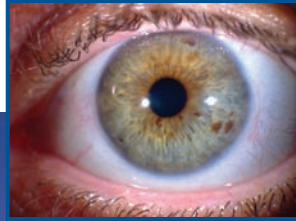
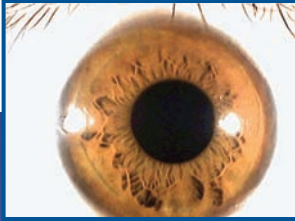




Clinical Iridology in Professional Practice
